

## Rosedale Traffic Calming Study

### Accident Data

The Austin Police Department has in its accident database from January 2002 to October 2007 a total of 67 accidents within the study boundary. There were likely many more accidents that did not get reported. These accidents are generally ones where there were injuries requiring transport or major property damage.

From the 67 accidents:

#### Type of accident

- 10 were vehicles running into fixed objects
- 11 were vehicles running into parked cars
- 11 were vehicles running into the rear end of another vehicle
- 1 was a vehicle hitting a pedestrian
- 4 were auto/bicycle accidents
- 25 were vehicles hitting at a right angle

#### Location

- 37 accidents were at intersections
- 30 accidents were in mid-block

#### Time of Day

- 6 were in the morning rush hour (7-9)
- 34 were in the middle of the day (9-4)
- 14 were in the evening rush hour (4-6)
- 8 were late at night (6-midnight)
- 5 were in the early morning (midnight -7)

#### Conditions

- 1 accident occurred when it was raining

#### Contributing Factor

- 8 listed failure to yield the right-of-way
- 4 listed running a stop sign
- 2 listed Excessive speed
- 2 listed DUI

34 of the accidents were on Medical Parkway
